



Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion

On Palm Sunday of the Lord's Passion, we enter into the most sacred week of the year. At the 9:30am Mass on Sunday, March 24, we will gather in the PAR and have a solemn procession into the church (going outside — weather permitting) to begin our liturgy. Our Parish Choir, along with additional instrumentalists, will lead the music at the 9:30am Mass. Plan to arrive early for this liturgy, to get into the proper location for participating in the procession.

Holy Thursday Food Collection

In the Gospel reading for the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, we hear Christ's words: 'For I have set you an example, that you should do as I have done to you.' (John 13:15) As we enter into the Paschal mystery of the Lord's death and resurrection, we are reminded to fulfill this command of service to each other, particularly to those less fortunate.

During our liturgy on Holy Thursday, we will have a collection of food for those less fortunate. You are invited to bring donations of non-perishable food items. Baskets will be available at various spots in the link, to deposit these food items. Some of these baskets will be brought forth in procession during the Preparation of the Gifts. All food collected will be donated to local food pantries.


'Glory to God'

As we enter into the Easter Triduum with the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, we celebrate with traditions. We recognize the importance of these days as central to our Catholic faith. We recall the sacrifice of Christ for all of us as we celebrate the Paschal Mystery – His suffering, dying, and rising.

During the liturgies for both Holy Thursday and Easter Vigil, we sing the Gloria, the Church's ancient hymn of praise. Tradition calls for ringing of bells during this hymn on these days. **On both these** evenings, you are asked to bring bells (any type) to our liturgy. We will ring these bells during the singing of the Gloria.

Lenten Confessions will be held on March 25th thru March 27 at 9:00 a.m. in the Church

Join us on Wednesday, March 27th for Night Prayer and to close the Adoration Chapel at 9:00 p.m.





Pontifical Good Friday Collection Friday March 29, 2024

During Holy Week, the Gospel readings come to life in a special way as we gather to celebrate the life, death and resurrection of Jesus. The readings remind us of our special connection to the Holy Land.

Christians in the Holy Land are experiencing unique hardships in these challenging times. Many Christians depend on the pilgrimage industry to live. They could not work during the pandemic and now the war has stopped pilgrims from coming. The Christians are now less than 2% of the Holy Land population, down from 23% a century ago. With the war, many more are thinking about leaving.

The Pontifical Good Friday Collection offers all Catholics an opportunity to express their solidarity with Christians in the Holy Land. A donation to the Holy Father's annual appeal is a direct way to make a difference in the lives of Christians. 

SJA Throwback — The Diocese of Joliet is Formed



Following World War II, the need for housing, services, and worship exploded for the families of the Post War "Baby Boom." With the demand for more churches and schools, the Catholic Church recognized a need to establish a separate diocese. On December 11, 1948, Pope Pius XII issued a decree establishing the Diocese of Joliet, formed from parts of the Archdiocese of Chicago, the Diocese of Rockford and Peoria, spanning seven counties and including seventy-two parishes. Four months later Martin D. McNamara, a native of Chicago, was installed as the first Bishop.

Now, St. Joan of Arc parish was no longer within the Chicago Archdiocese, but the newly-formed Joliet Diocese, continuing under the direction and care of the priests of St. Procopius Abbey and the Sisters of Sacred Heart Monastery. St. Joan of Arc parishioners, ever generous, also contributed to the building of the new cathedral, St. Raymond Nonnatus. It is the rich multi-colored marble interior, statuary, and striking windows which combine to make the cathedral one of the diocese's most impressive structures.

Question: Why is it so important that we register in a parish? Isn't it good enough that we go to Mass?

Answer:

Registration is the official way we join a parish community. Many people think that because they attend a particular parish they automatically belong. At times, young adults who have moved away for years think they are still signed up under their parents. But membership requires signing up, formally enrolling yourself in a parish. Registration is a commitment to a community, a way to be included in the religious, social, and ministerial activities of your parish. Your registration affects the parish in many ways. Census numbers can determine how many priests are assigned to a church, what benefits and obligations the community has to the diocese, and how Masses, Confessions, and devotions are planned and scheduled.

Registration shows you belong. It is also necessary for certain benefits, like scheduling sacraments, obtaining sponsor certificates, and getting donation statements for taxes. Most importantly, it lets the parish count on you, to call on you to assist in its mission. Registering in your parish is a statement of faith and confidence in the life and work of your parish.
